Edgemoor Site Sold to Port of Wilmington

On February 27, 2017, the Port of Wilmington purchased the 112-acre Edgemoor site from Chemours for \$10 million. Chemours had operated a titanium dioxide production center on the site until 2015. The Port will be seeking private investors and businesses to build a container and shipping terminal.
