Rules & Regulations

Reservations for rooms at the Dobisky Center must be made in person with payment.

The meeting rooms are to be left in the same condition as found and garbage disposed of in containers provided.

User is responsible for set up and cleaning of room. An adult must supervise children at all times.

If kitchen is used, you must clean the area prior to leaving. Failure to comply will result in a damage charge at the cost of the room rented.

Any damage or broken equipment should be reported to Dobisky Center staff immediately.

Alcohol is not allowed to be sold or brought into the Dobisky Center without prior Alcohol Policy purchased. For more information on Alcohol Policy, contact the City Clerk at 315-393-6100.

No smoking within 25 feet of all entry ways. This includes patio doors as well.

The Dobisky Center is open Monday through Sunday from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. Rooms are available only during those times unless pre-approved by the City Manager.

The Dobisky Visitors' Center is overseen by the Ogdensburg Parks & Recreation Department which also operates the Richard G. Lockwood Civic Center, the Elsa M. Luksich Municipal Pool, the municipal marina as well as aHamilton, New York Avenue, Grove Street and Montroy parks as well as Kids Kingdom in the Greenbelt.

During the months of June, July and August, the Ogdensburg Parks & Recreation Department offers week-long camps for boys' and girls' basketball, football, gymnastics, cheerleading, track, hockey, soccer, baseball, softball, lacrosse, wrestling and volleyball.

The department also offers Biddy Basketball for K-6, winter gymnastics, wrestling and family swim during the winter months.
